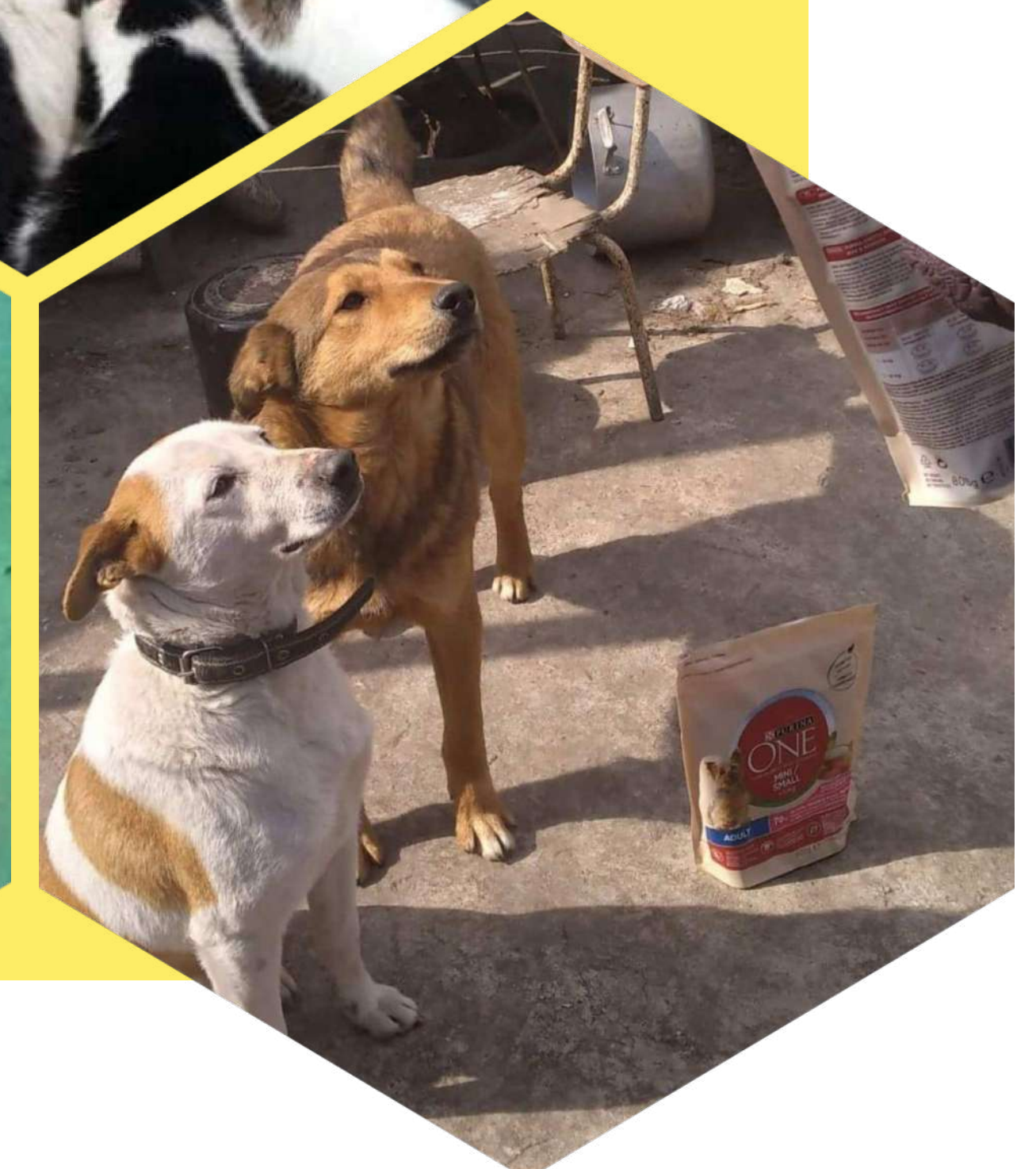




UPAW

UPAW - is the partnership of organizations joined under a goal to reach the welfare of animals in Ukraine.

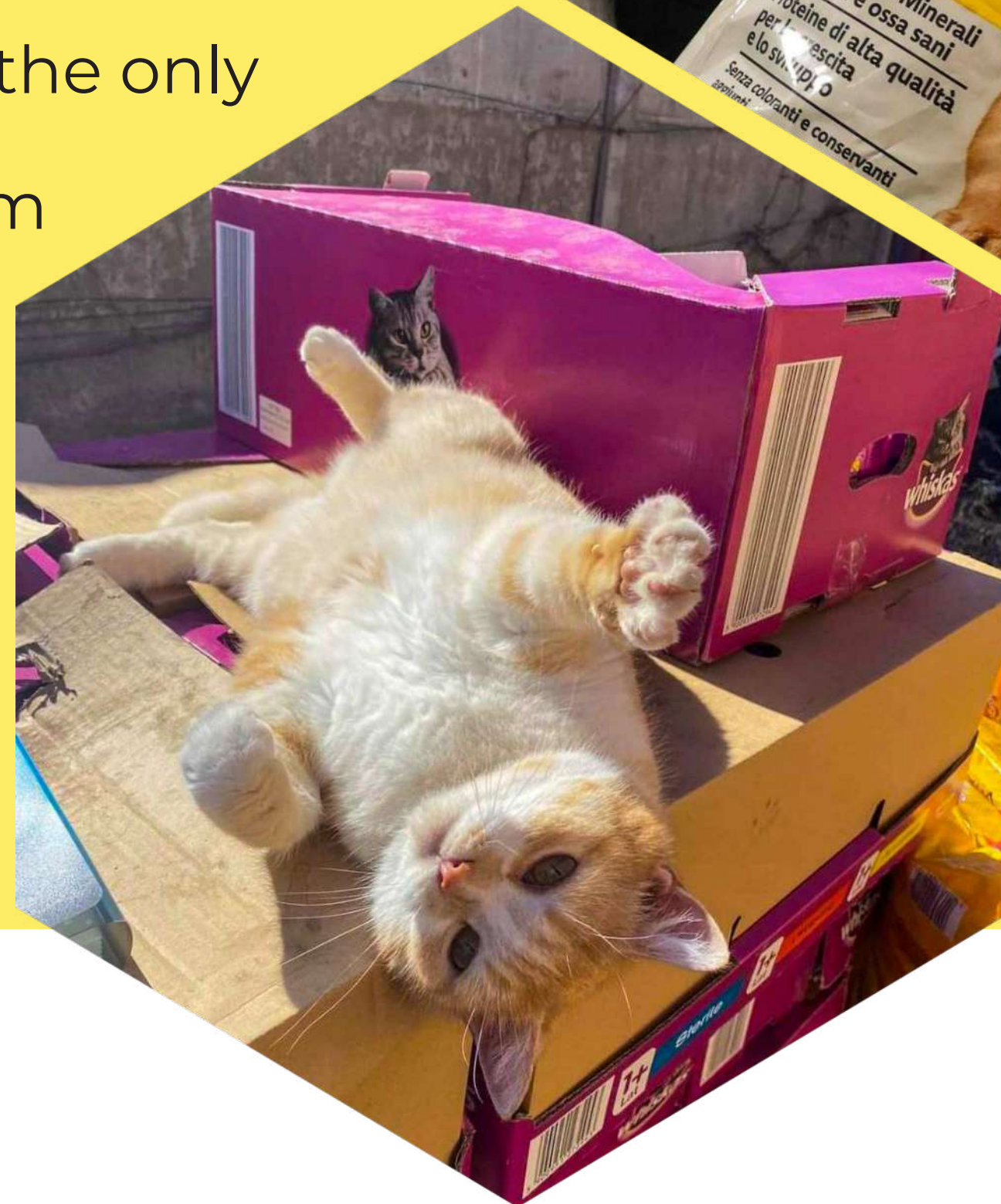
The UPAW's first project is the campaign for pet food delivery to the war-torn regions of Ukraine towards the mitigation of the humanitarian crisis that touched the most vulnerable citizens of Ukraine - dogs and cats.



Nowadays, the campaign unites the efforts of 16 organizations from the civil sector, as well as representatives of business and governmental authorities.

UPAW is one of three signature parties and the only animal welfare organization in Memorandum for pet humanitarian supplies initiated by the State Service of Ukraine on Food Safety and Consumer Protection

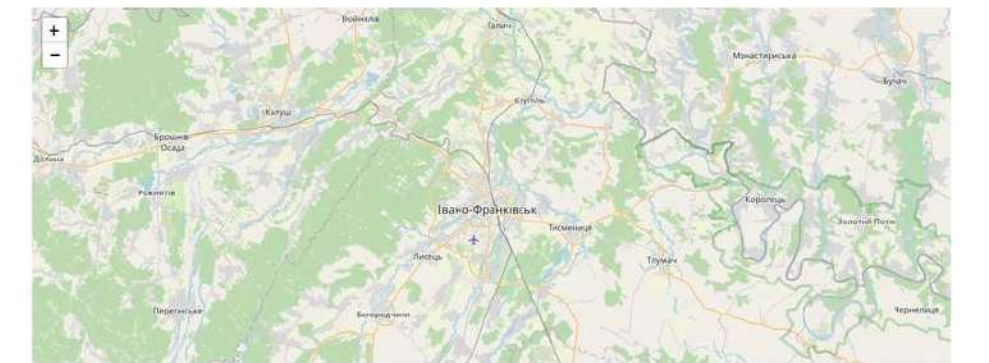

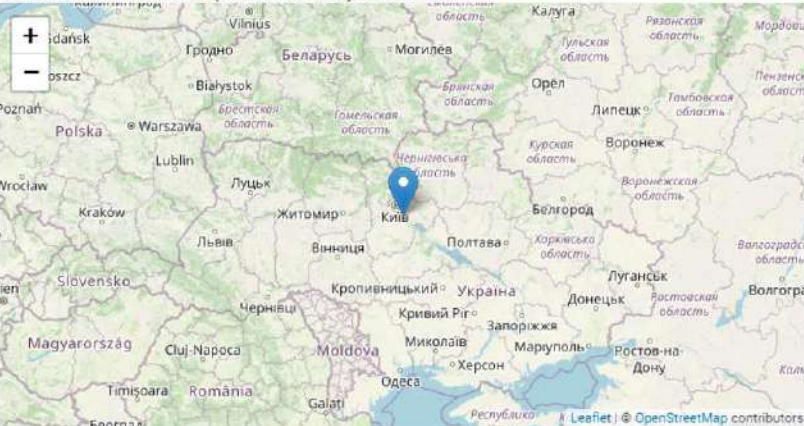

NGO "Alternative Control" - a public organization, which was established in 2019. EDRPOU 42769874.

The main purpose of the organization is to protect animals from cruelty, the solution of animal protection problems. Today, the city has more than 200 stray dogs and 300 cats, which are cared for by a volunteer network. The network includes more than 50 volunteers who feed and care for homeless animals on a regular basis. We have previously collaborated with "Four Paws", Animal ID and more.

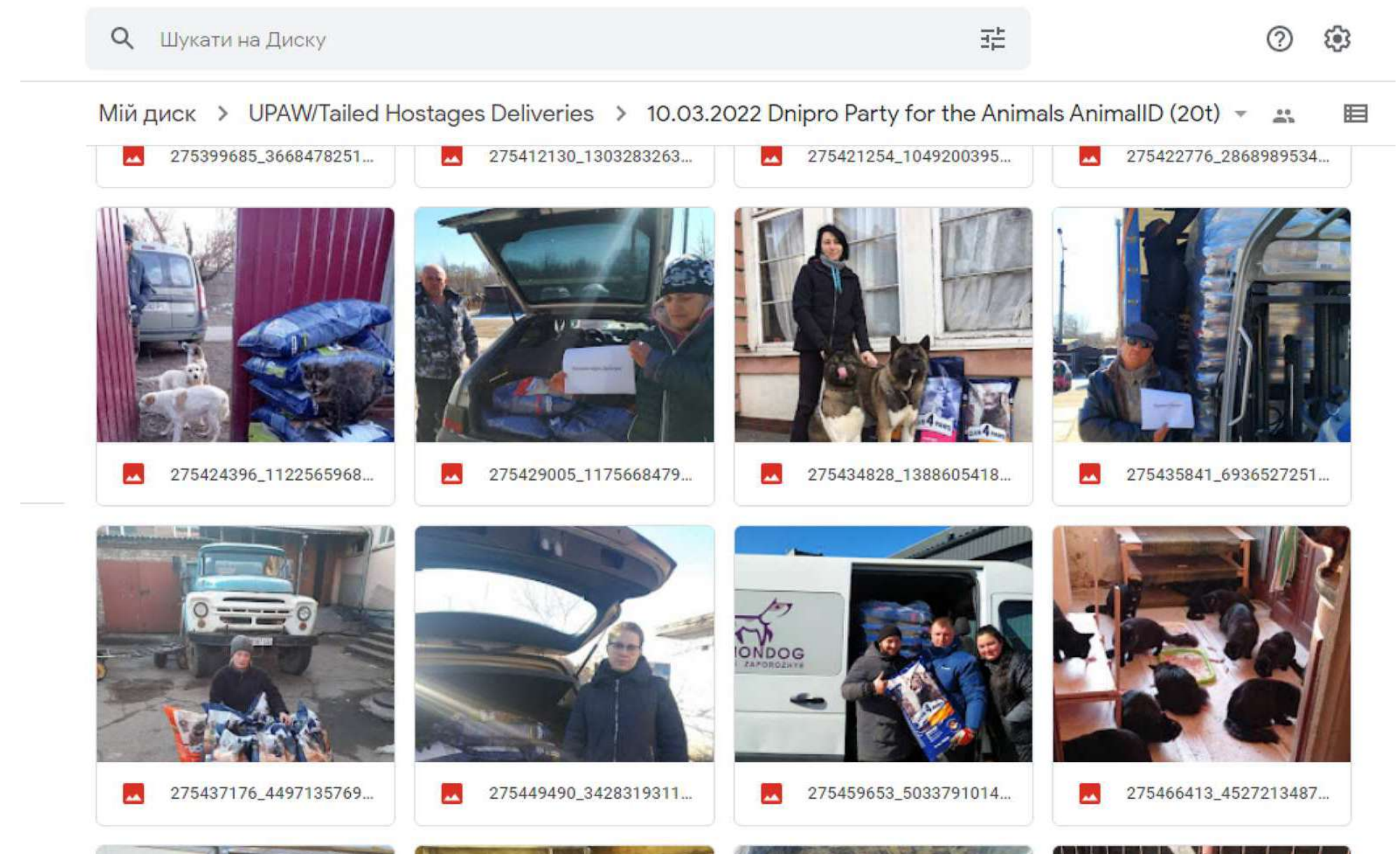
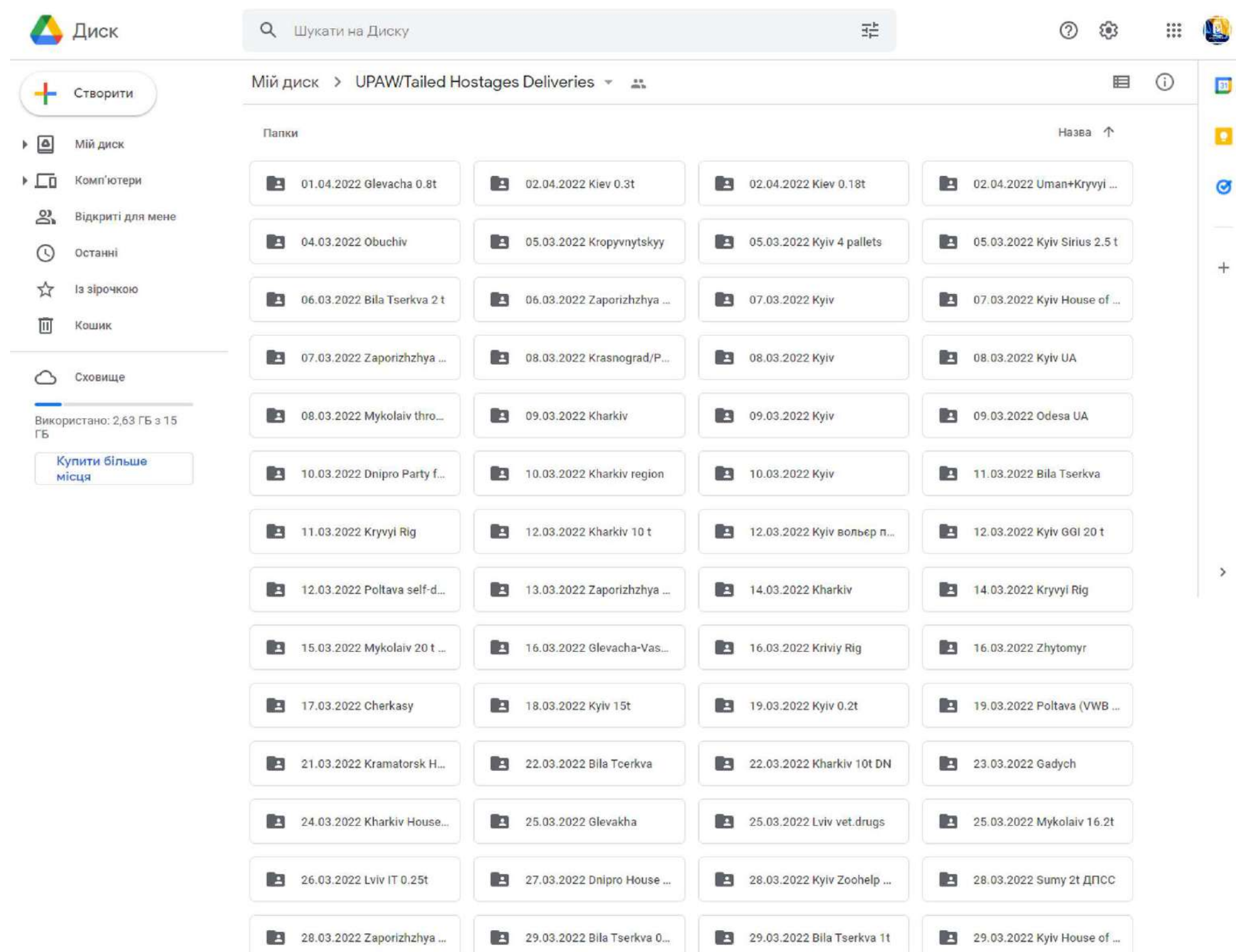

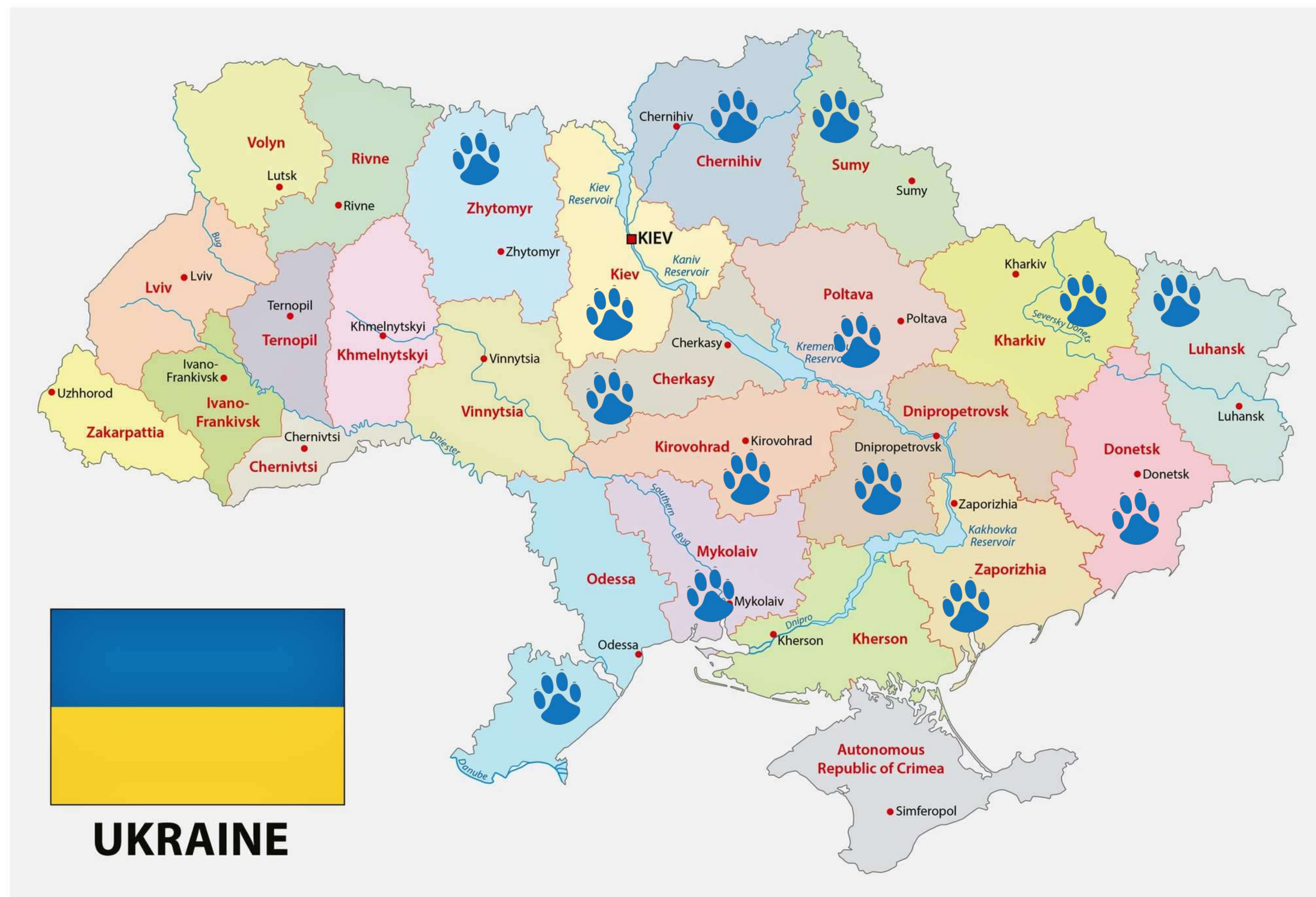
